

Adoption Contract

This is an agreement between Noah's Kingdom and the adopter.

I realize that I am taking responsibility for an animal and this is a long-term commitment. If a cat is cared for properly, its life span can exceed 15 years. I fully understand the expenses as well as the moral obligation of caring for a cat. I promise to provide a safe and loving home for my new pet.

I agree to provide fresh food and water for my pet daily. I will provide a comfortable and quiet place for my pet to sleep. I will take my pet to the vet whenever he/she is ill and for medical checkups on a yearly basis.

I always promise to keep my pet indoors or on a leash and harness whenever I must take him/her outdoors. I will NOT declaw the cat.

If, for any reason, my new pet does not acclimate to his/her new home, or at any time I am unable to care for my new pet, I agree to return the adopted pet to Noah's Kingdom Humane Society so a suitable home may be found for the animal. In this case I agree to notify the organization (contact info at bottom) before returning the cat to them ample time to arrange for space for the cat.

If paying by check and my check is returned unpaid for any reason. I agree to reimburse Noah's Kingdom Humane Society for all expenses incurred as a result.

I hereby indemnify and hold harmless Noah's Kingdom Humane Society for any and all injuries or damages caused by my cat. I hereby release Noah's Kingdom Humane Society from any liability for any defects that my cat may have or develop and for any injuries or damages my cat may cause.

I have answered all questions on the adoption application truthfully and I understand my signature is my guarantee to uphold the terms of this agreement. If I do not care for the adopted animal under terms of this agreement Noah's Kingdom will obtain all rights to the animal.
